<b>High Quality PE Provision (Sports Coaches to run afterschool clubs)</b>	£7436.00	£2018	High quality Sports and PE lessons that are enjoyed by the pupils. This impact is measured via observation and photographic evidence and an increase in the uptake of school clubs. Pupils are able to move forward in their base skills – ie gymnastics and problem solving. Clubs: Netball, Football, Gymnastics
<b>High Quality Swimming Tuition (All year round swimming for all year groups)</b>	£19920	£6322	All pupils swim every week year round. This is measured by the proportion of the whole school nearing/swimming 25m. Year 6 children are able to swim 25m by the time they leave.
<b>Provision of Sports Equipment (Skipping)</b>	£538	£538	With the correct equipment there are more opportunities for the children to participate in workshops. This carries forward to playtimes where equipment is provided for the children to play with. Pupils are able to use skills learnt.
<b>Provision of Sports Equipment (Boccia)</b>	£107	£107	With the purchased Boccia equipment there are more opportunities for SEN/Less physically able children to participate in competitions and events. Pupil enjoyment for those taking part and more events become available and open to children.
<b>Provision of Sports Equipment (Gymnastics)</b>	£125	£125	With the correct equipment there are more opportunities for the children to participate in competitions. Pupil enjoyment is increased and evidence via photographs. Skills are improved. Pupils were able to take part in 6 weeks of in school training and 1 week at Orchard Gym to improve skills.
