## Year 5 – Cinema Trip

As part of our topic this year we have been lucky enough to secure tickets to go and watch the film 'Zoo' at Cineworld in Yeovil on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> November.

The film is an Irish drama set during World War Two, just before the start of a series of German air raids on the nation's capital in 1941, known as the Belfast Blitz. 12 year-old Tom is the son of a veterinarian who has been sent to war and, like his father, shares a special connection with the zoo animals, especially with an African elephant called Buster. When the Ministry of Defence orders for the animals to be put down in fear that they may be dangerous if they escape during raids, Tom, his bother Mickey and their friends form a plan to save Buster. This touching family film – which is partly based on a true story – presents this important event in Irish history with young people as the heroes of the story.

This is a PG certificate film so please return this slip if you **do not** want your child to participate in this trip. Slips must be returned by Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> November but only if you **do not** wish them to watch the film.

There is no charge for this trip as the screening is offered as part of the 'Into Film' festival.
